CONTENUTI LINGUISTICI

1. Present simple/ Present continuous, dynamic and stative verbs; Articles.
Vocabulary: collocations with *make* and *do*; Phrasal Verbs (1)
2. Past simple /Past continuous/ *used to*.
Vocabulary: irregular verbs (the group list); describing people and their clothes.
3. Present Perfect simple/Present perfect continuous; Comparatives and superlatives; Question tags.
Vocabulary: word formation and word families.

DIDATTICA A DISTANZA

4. Future forms (Present tenses for the future; *be going to*; *will/shall*; future continuous, future perfect); *when/while/before/after/as soon as/until/till* + present simple/present perfect; linkers of cause (*as, since, because, because of*) and effect (*so, as a result, as a consequence, consequently, thus*).
Vocabulary: the weather; Phonetics: homophones.

 - From the *General Prologue*: *The Knight, The Prioress, The Merchant, The Wife of Bath, The Pardoner*.
